The Samuelson Clinic offers this post-graduate position to provide a recent law school graduate the opportunity to develop as an effective advocate and teacher while working with the Clinic to help train the next generation of influential attorneys, judges, and community leaders specializing in technology law and policy. The ideal candidate will have a background, and interest, in intellectual property, and telecommunications law and policy.

The position is anticipated to begin no later than January 6, 2020 but an earlier start date may be possible. The position will continue until June 30, 2021, with the possibility of renewal for an additional year. This is a full-time represented position, with a salary rate of \$72,170.

- * Intensive supervision of clinical students and their caseloads;
- * Teaching and curriculum development for the Samuelson Clinic seminar classes;
- * Participation in on-going advocacy efforts with state and federal legislatures, courts, and agencies;
